3. Our Spiritual Gifts

Definition of spiritual gift

A God-given ability of Christ which God entrusts to each of His people in order to involve them in the task of bringing healing to an alienated world.

1 Peter 4:10-11

¹⁰ As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

Whoever speaks, let him speak, as it were, the utterances of God; whoever serves, let him do so as by the strength which God supplies; so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

1) Every Christian is given at least one spiritual gift to be used in ministry.

1 Peter 4:10

¹⁰ As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

2) The Holy Spirit is the One who supplies the gifts and does so as He pleases.

1 Corinthians 12:11

¹¹ But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills.

1 Corinthians 14:1

¹ Pursue love, yet desire earnestly spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.

3) Christians have differing gifts and no one has all the gifts.
