1. An Insurmountable Debt (DEBT)

Psalm 51:5

⁵ Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin my mother conceived me.

Col. 2:13-14

- ¹³ When you were dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He made you alive together with Him, having forgiven us all our transgressions,
- ¹⁴ having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

Romans 3:10

¹⁰ as it is written, "There is none righteous, not even one;"

Romans 3:23

²³ for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

2. An Estranged Relationship (ENEMY)

Colossians 2:14

¹⁴ having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross.

Romans 8:7

⁷ because the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able to do so,

- ⁹ not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Romans 5:1-2

- ¹ Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- ² through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.
