- <sup>3</sup> Give ear and come to me; hear me, that your soul may live. I will make an everlasting covenant with you, my faithful love promised to David.
- <sup>4</sup> See, I have made him a witness to the peoples, a leader and commander of the peoples.
- <sup>5</sup> Surely you will summon nations you know not, and nations that do not know will hasten to you, because of the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, for he has endowed you with splendor."
- <sup>6</sup> Seek the LORD while he may be found; call on him while he is near.
- <sup>7</sup>Let the wicked forsake his way and the evil man his thoughts. Let him turn to the LORD, and he will have mercy on him, and to our God, for he will freely pardon.
- <sup>8</sup> "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the LORD.
- <sup>9</sup> "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."
