Philippians 4:10-19

¹⁰ But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly, that now at last you have revived your concern for me; indeed, you were concerned before, but you lacked opportunity.

¹¹ Not that I speak from want, for I have learned to be content in whatever circumstances I am.

¹² I know how to get along with humble means, and I also know how to live in prosperity; in any and every circumstance I have learned the secret of being filled and going hungry, both of having abundance and suffering need.

¹³ I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.

¹⁴ Nevertheless, you have done well to share with me in my affliction.

¹⁵ You yourselves also know, Philippians, that at the first preaching of the gospel, after I left Macedonia, no church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving but you alone;

¹⁶ for even in Thessalonica you sent a gift more than once for my needs.

¹⁷ Not that I seek the gift itself, but I seek for the profit which increases to your account.

¹⁸ But I have received everything in full and have an abundance; I am amply supplied, having received from Epaphroditus what you have sent, a fragrant aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, well-pleasing to God.

¹⁹ And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

- 1) God Has Given A Promissory Note Guaranteeing He Will Meet The Needs Of All Christians Who Qualify.

Promissory Note

A written promise guaranteeing a specific payment and meeting described conditions.

- 2) The Believers Who Qualify For This Provision Are Those Whose Use Of Life And Resources Reflect A Theocentric Generosity.

2 Corinthians 9:6

⁶ Now this I say, he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.

Proverbs 3:9-10

*⁹ Honor the Lord from your wealth and from the first of all your produce;
¹⁰ So your barns will be filled with plenty and your vats will overflow with new wine.*

Malachi 3:10

- 3) "God's Riches In Glory In Christ Jesus" Is The Collateral Upon Which His Promise Is Made.

Collateral

Security given as a pledge for the fulfillment of one's promise.

- 4) God' Promissory Note Will Never Be Redeemed Without A Demonstration Of Faith.
