Hebrews 4:12-16

<sup>12</sup> For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

<sup>13</sup> And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

14 Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

<sup>15</sup> For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.

<sup>16</sup> Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

- Our confidence to approach God begins with an <u>embrace</u> of our <u>condition</u>.

- 2. Our confidence to approach God is lost when our <u>performance</u> is our <u>platform</u>.
- 3. Our confidence to approach God is sure when <u>Christ</u> is our <u>standing</u>. (v. 14-16)
