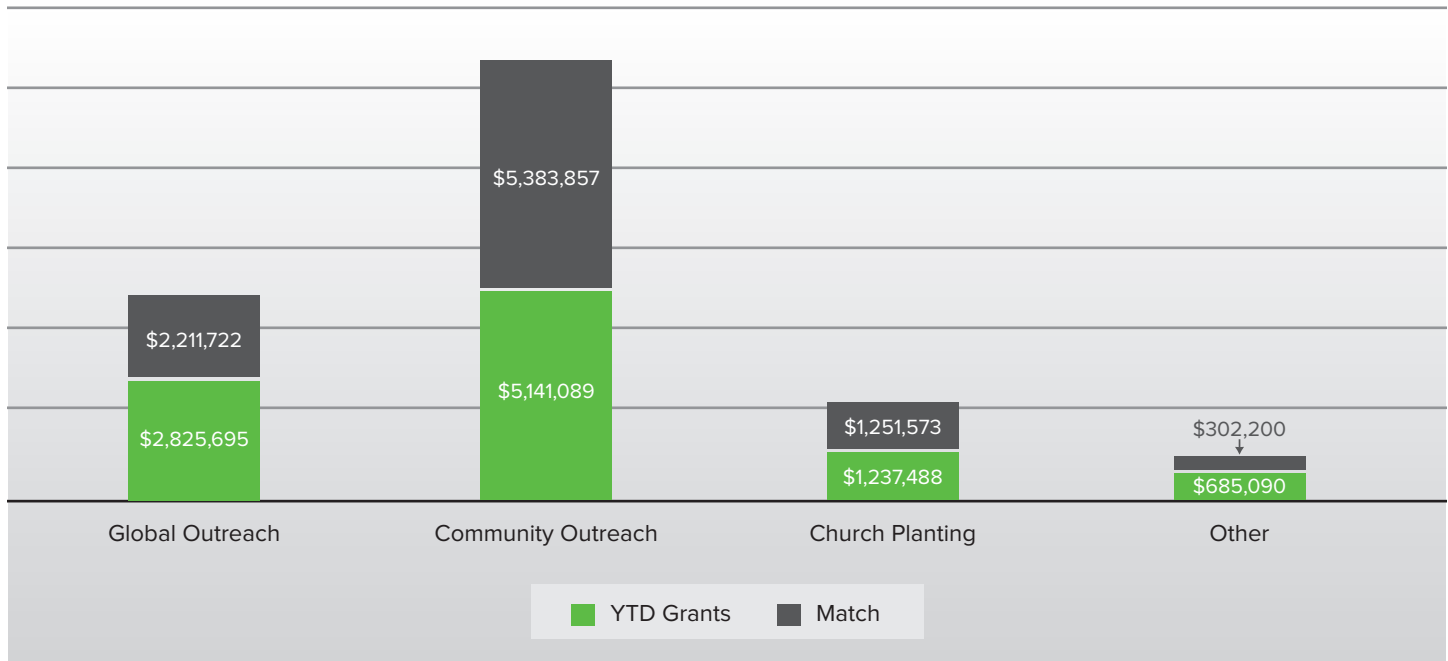


## Kingdom Investments

# Kingdom Investments FY17 Grants Awarded to Date

## **City of Refuge..... \$250,000**

This grant is for the acquisition, renovation and initial launch of a restoration home for rescued female adult victims of Human trafficking and operating expenses for the first year.

## **Metro Atlanta Collective ..... \$100,000**

The Metro Atlanta Collective is a church plant network that provides training, support and networking for planters. This grant is to fund a portion of the salary for a full time Executive Director over a 2-year period.

## **North Fulton Community Charities ..... \$10,000**

This grant is to help underwrite the cost of North Fulton Community Charities free educational center. The center offers workforce/life- skills readiness classes, ESL, Computer readiness, and GED prep classes. The center connects clients to jobs and services with the goal of self-sufficiency.

## **Mana de Vida ..... \$111,000**

Mana de Vida is a Christian school in Escuintla, Guatemala. Perimeter's Global Outreach sends GO Journey groups and teachers there to serve. The school has outgrown their current building and wishes to add services that a new space will allow them to provide in order to be the epicenter for life transformation in their city.

## **SAFFT ..... \$34,000**

SAFFT (Supporting Adoption & Foster Families Together, Inc.) provides a safe place for families to have court ordered supervised visitation. This grant is to help renovate their offices to include a family counseling center.

## **Christ the King ..... \$50,000**

Christ the King is a Church Planting network in the Boston area. This grant is to help fund a Leadership Development Director.

## **Human Coalition ..... \$75,000**

Human Coalition will use this grant to hire a new clinic director for Cura clinic operated by Human Coalition in Atlanta. Human Coalition guides hurting men and women through unexpected pregnancy.

## **Christian Library International..... \$40,000**

Christian Library International provides Christian books and resources to prisons. Their grant will be used to secure a part-time warehouse coordinator and equipment to complete the Georgia Hub.

## **Atlanta Mission..... \$40,000**

The Atlanta Mission's grant will fund a care team to implement "Make Progress" services at the men's facilities.

## **Metro Atlanta Youth for Christ..... \$5,000**

Metro Atlanta Youth for Christ will be expanding their Campus Life clubs to Pinckneyville Middle School and Lilburn Middle School.

## **Church Plants Outside Metro Atlanta..... \$180,000**

Perimeter is helping plant churches in:

# Kingdom Investments FY17 Grants Awarded to Date

**Egypt..... \$106,740**

We are supporting evangelism events that are being organized with the goal of impacting 10 strategic cities in Egypt.

**Metro Atlanta Seminary..... \$71,250**

Metro Atlanta Seminary’s grant will allow them to hire a part-time person to lead, promote, and make infrastructure changes to MAS so that it can grow.

**Hi-Hope.....\$50,000**

Hi-Hope will use its grant to renovate the Lifelong Learning Center. Hi-Hope is a day program for disabled adults and many in the Perimeter family — including classes of students from Perimeter Christian School —serve there.

**Gospel Joy (Poland).....\$32,000**

This completes a three-year grant to the Gospel Joy project. KI funded the first two years of the project and was very excited to learn that Gospel Joy has exceeded predicted outcomes, planting more churches and training more leaders than originally planned.
