A new program we are launching, called **The Pipeline Career Program**. Pipeline impacts young people, their communities, and businesses. It does so by taking high-impact young people with integrity, excellent work ethic, and skills and connecting them to transformational companies.

CLIPrison Alliance

- Two permanent volunteers for both Monday and Thursday mornings to process Bibles and books destined for correctional facilities.
- One permanent male volunteer in good physical health for Thursday mornings. This person must be willing to do physical/manual activities and should have an SUV/pickup type vehicle for occasionally helping to transport boxes of books/Bibles from a nearby warehouse to the CLIPA Buford Shipping Center. (Requires lifting boxes up to 50 lbs.)

City of Refuge

- The 345: Men's Campus which is opening at the start of 2023.
- Our Staff: to continue pushing forward knowing God will work all things for His good.
- Our residents: We hope all the women and children on campus are able to move towards what God has in store for them.

Friends of Refugees

- Pray for the refugee families that we come alongside as friends, that the peace and comfort of the Lord will come to those who have experienced high levels of trauma and distress.
- Our Staff: that we can work well as a team, lift one another up, and experience rest and love that can only come from the Father.
- Our Spaces: That our offices, classrooms, living rooms, garden, and other spaces will be places where refugees experience love, rest, and community.
- Our Volunteers and Supporters: That together we experience solidarity with families who were forced to flee their homes for fear of persecution and death, just as Jesus's own family was forced to flee violence and terror (Matthew 2:13-18). That together we encounter Jesus where he promised we could find him among the strangers and migrants who need our welcome and support (Matthew 25:34-40).
