- All <u>Scripture</u> is <u>breathed out</u> by God and <u>profitable</u> for teaching, for <u>reproof</u>, for correction, and for training in <u>righteousness</u>,
- that the man of God may be <u>complete</u>, equipped for every good work.

Scripture: the Bible breathed out: given profitable: good for reproof: discipline righteousness: what is right and holy complete: ready

Q. 52. What kind of life did Christ live on earth?

A. A life of obedience, service, and suffering.
