- Not only that, but we rejoice in our <u>sufferings</u>, knowing that suffering <u>produces</u> <u>endurance</u>,
- and endurance produces <u>character</u>, and character produces <u>hope</u>,
- and hope does not put us to <u>shame</u>, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

sufferings: difficult or bad circumstances

produces: creates (develops)

endurance: patience (the ability to continue in difficult circumstances)

character: good qualities in a person that show he's becoming more like Jesus

hope: knowing that good will come

shame: embarrassment
