The Rock: *a name of God used to show His strength as the defender of Israel*

justice: *right and fair*

iniquity: *sin*

upright: *good and trustworthy*

DID YOU KNOW? Moses wrote the book of Deuteronomy which means “second law.” Before the Israelites entered the Promised Land, God once again reminded His people that He was their God, He had led them out of slavery in Egypt and He had called them to obey His law. In Deuteronomy He gives His people the Ten Commandments for a second time (the first is recorded in Exodus 20).

WHAT DOES IT MEAN? God knew that His people would turn from Him and look for greatness in other things (idols). These verses are part of a song God told Moses to teach the Israelites to help them remember His goodness. God is faithful, just, and upright. Always. He never changes. Our good and faithful God always keeps His promises, including sending his Son, Jesus, to be our Savior. Sending Jesus to deliver us from sin and giving us the power to live His way is God’s greatest promise of all! Because of Jesus we can proclaim the greatness of our God and glorify His name!
