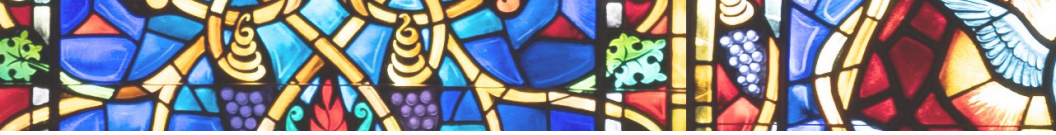


A CELEBRATION OF THE LIFE OF

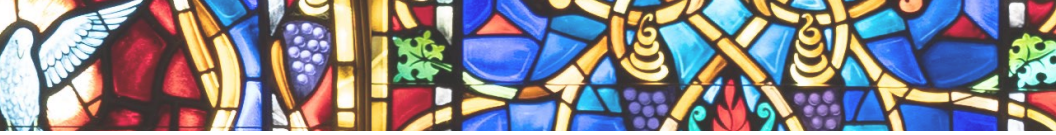
