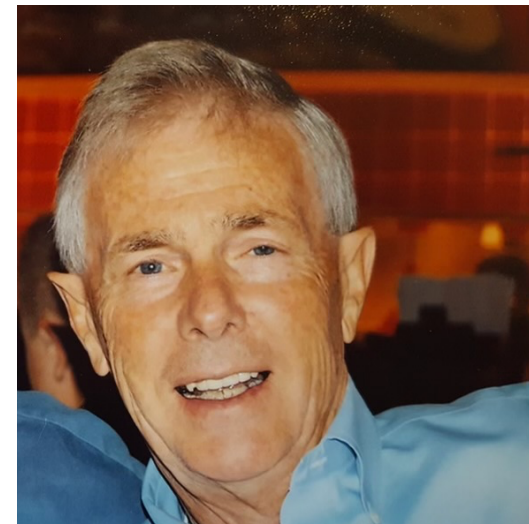
November 13, 1935- June 29, 2022
