She graduated from Washington State University with a teaching degree and earned a Master's in early childhood education years later. She married Rod Anderson in 1962, and they had daughter Terra and son Matt. She taught elementary school in California, Colorado, and Georgia. After almost 40 years of marriage, Rod passed away in 2001; and Jacque subsequently married fellow Turlock High School graduate John Shaffer in 2004. John and Jacque thoroughly enjoyed retired life together.

A remarkable wife, mother and grandmother, Jacque listened intently, encouraged wonderfully and inspired the continual love of learning. She loved gardening, home decorating, sewing, baking cookies and spending quality time with family and friends.
