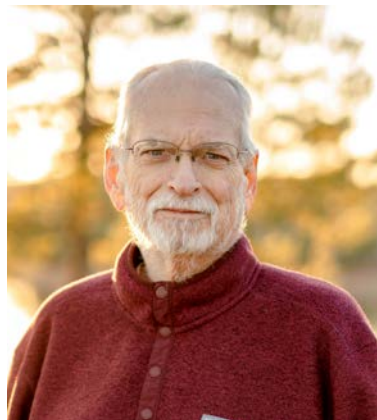

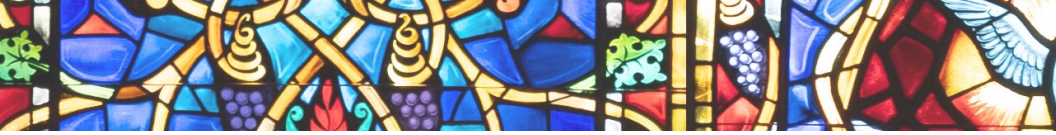

Jeff was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, son, brother, and friend whose life was rooted in faith, family, and service to others.

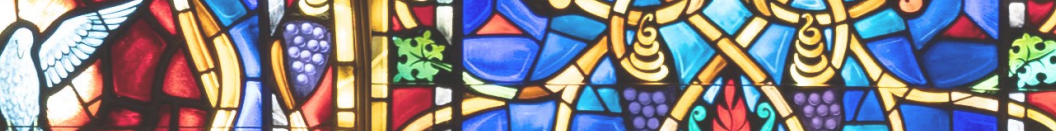
