


“Only one



1) What does it mean to
“bear witness to the truth?”

- 1) There are two radically different realities, earthly and heavenly.
- 2) Jesus came in His earthly nature to show what heavenly reality is!

2) Who are those “who are of the truth?”

Jesus came from the heavenly reality into the earthly reality to rescue those who were made citizens of heaven before the earth was even created. *Ephesians 1:4*

3) What does Jesus mean, “to hear His Voice?”
