

FACTS ABOUT PERIMETER CHURCH

History

- Perimeter was founded in 1977 by Randy Pope
- Our first meeting in September of 1977 on Buford Highway had 20 attendees
- The Church has been on 6 campuses before landing at our current location
- We were founded on small group discipleship and that continues to be the foundation of Perimeter
- Perimeter is part of the Presbyterian Church of America

Why the name “Perimeter” Church?

Perimeter began with a desire to see God do an unusual work in the city of Atlanta. Its vision is to see the entire city brought into an encounter with the Kingdom of God.

Our current facility

- Opened in August 1996
- Auditorium seats 2,200
- Contains nine auditoriums
- Sits on 110 acres
- Average weekend attendance: 4,000
- 4,500 members

Outreach

- 12 global partner countries with a goal of 20 before 2020
- More than 100 churches planted globally as a result of partnerships with Perimeter
- Community Outreach partners with 27 ministries in and around the area to serve

Students and Children

- The Kidstown and KidsQuest children’s ministries average 1,500 children attending per week
- The children’s ministries have 730 children in life-on-life missional discipleship
- The student ministries of Jhi and Watershed have a weekly attendance of more than 300 students
- Student ministries have over 500 students in life-on-life missional discipleship
- Goldrush, a yearly student-led equipping conference, had more than 800 students being equipped and serving the community for a week

Church Planting

- Each year two in-residence church planters are hired for a two-year internship
- Perimeter currently has 22 daughter churches, 4 granddaughter churches and 2 great granddaughter churches.

Perimeter Christian School

- Covenant philosophy (at least one parent must be a Christian; parents assist, especially in lower grades)
- Kindergarten –8th grades
- More than 500 students

We plan to make mature and equipped followers of Christ by:

- 1) Winsomely engaging the unchurched where we live, work and play.
- 2) Attractively exposing the unchurched to God's Word and God's people.
- 3) Sponsoring newcomers into church membership.
- 4) Discipling members in life-on-life missional discipleship.

We plan to bring about family transformation by:

- 1) Equipping children & youth to understand the gospel and to embrace a biblical world and life view.
- 2) Equipping singles to leverage their missional mobility and to make wise marital decisions.
- 3) Equipping marrieds to delight in their God-given roles and to fulfill their God-given responsibilities.
- 4) Equipping parents to develop a family plan and to shepherd their children's hearts.

We plan to deploy our people for community and global transformation by:

- 1) Serving people in need.
- 2) Partnering with other churches and organizations.
- 3) Planting new churches.
- 4) Exporting life-on-life missional discipleship to churches worldwide.
