Joy of All Nations serves Northeast Atlanta, a rapidly diversifying, affluent, and family-friendly area. With a large East Asian and the nation's fastest-growing South Asian population, we believe God has uniquely equipped us to reach this community with the gospel.

- For our Elder training
- For the hiring of two key roles: Worship Leader and Youth Ministry Leader

PARTNERING 10+ YEARS

Born from a simple idea by Perimeter volunteers, Fully Furnished connects furniture donors to those in need. Now the only furniture bank north of US 285, it shares the gospel through the gift of furniture, household items, linens, and prayer—helping refugees, fire victims, abuse survivors, veterans, and more. In hard times, a furnished home offers hope, dignity, and a fresh start.

Reflect and **Respond**

“Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving. At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ, on account of which I am in prison—that I may make it clear, which is how I ought to speak.”

Kindred Hope

PASTOR HOWARD BROWN

Kindred Hope Church is a new church plant in the City of South Fulton, Atlanta. We're passionate about being a refuge of God's grace and peace, a fellowship for Christ followers and seekers, and a gospel movement of marketplace leaders. We seek to reach an area of Atlanta that is underrepresented in our denomination.

- For our transition to public worship this fall or early next year
- For strong fundraising and generous, long-term partners
- For new leaders on staff as they settle in

DAY 6

C U M M I N G

No Longer Bound

PARTNERING 10+ YEARS

No Longer Bound (NLB) is a long-term, residential, faith-based program for men in addiction. Research shows that long-term sobriety is dependent on adequate length of treatment. NLB's twelve-month program, which gives men the time they need to uncover the root cause of their addiction, is comprehensive. Their approach is designed to transform lives beyond sobriety through lasting intimacy with God, self, and others.



PRAY

- For the men and their families who are deeply impacted by their former addiction
- Pray that they will be fully healed and freed from their bonds of substance abuse

DAY 7

THAILAND

NightLight International

PARTNER SINCE 2002

NightLight is an international organization compelled by love to reach out to, rescue, and restore all those who are negatively impacted by human trafficking.



PRAY

- For the thousands of human trafficking victims who have been released from scam centers in Myanmar and are now in Thailand, as the government has asked NightLight to assist in their care
- Pray also for the full caseload of trafficked women that NightLight is currently helping as they walk the road to recovery and eventual repatriation

DAY 8

Reflect and Respond

“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.”

Joshua 1:9 ESV

PRAY

As Joshua prepared to lead the people of Israel into the Promised Land, God reminded them not to focus on the unknown ahead. He reminded His people they knew Him, and that He would not only be with them, but had gone before them.

Into what unknown and unfamiliar space might God be leading you? What people or places might He be prompting your heart to pursue?

Pray for those people or places today, and that God would give you courage to step into those spaces with a posture of radical dependence.

City Church Eastside

City Church-Eastside, located in the heart of Atlanta, is “joining God, as a family on mission, for the renewal of all things.” To accomplish this, we seek to “grow people to love Atlanta through the power of Jesus Christ.” Nearly twenty years old, we practice discipleship and mission across ten Eastside neighborhoods.



PRAY

We desperately need to find a new worship site in the next 12 months as we have outgrown our current location but space is difficult to find and afford (we want to purchase)—please ask God to provide!

Wellspring Living

PARTNERING 10+ YEARS

Since 2001, Wellspring Living has provided support to survivors and those in danger of experiencing domestic trafficking in Atlanta. Serving youth and women ages 12–39, their programs teach life skills and promote recovery. Through residential and community care, including a Women’s Academy and a youth receiving center, they aim to restore physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being for all they serve.



PRAY

For healing and transformation to come to the women who have fled abusive relationships and to find true life in Christ!

DAY 11

GUATEMALA

Vida Real

PARTNER SINCE 1990

Vida Real is a multi-location church that provides a safe spiritual home for each person to grow and develop in a healthy and holistic way.



PRAY

That Life on Life missional discipleship will take root and bring the deep equipping we need to spread the gospel and see true transformation, as this opportunity comes after many years of relationship with Perimeter and a growing desire for a more intentional discipleship process

Reflect and Respond

PRAY

For the Lord to raise an army of missional, evangelistically-minded Christ followers, anointed by the Holy Spirit, to proclaim the glory of the Good News of Jesus winsomely to our segment of the city

Kids Hope USA

PARTNERING 10+ YEARS

“How can churches best impact America’s children?” The founder of Kids Hope USA found the answer: “fill the relational voids in their lives.” This faith-based mentoring program pairs churches with local schools, connecting students to caring, consistent adults who show up weekly—just for them. Today, Perimeter has 52 Kids Hope mentors serving in seven local schools.

TANZANIA

Ubora

PARTNER SINCE 2003

Starting from a humble two-room school in a remote Tanzanian village, Pastor Warieli has served the widows and the orphans of the area to bring flourishing that caught the attention of the national government.



PRAY

- For the new STEM school that is being built, because it plugs a vital hole in the pipeline for the development of the kids as they go from primary school to secondary school
- For the widows and the babas (elder men) of the village to continue to serve their own people

DAY 16

Reflect and Respond

“And they devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. And all who believed were together and had all things in common. And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, praising God and having favor with all the people.
