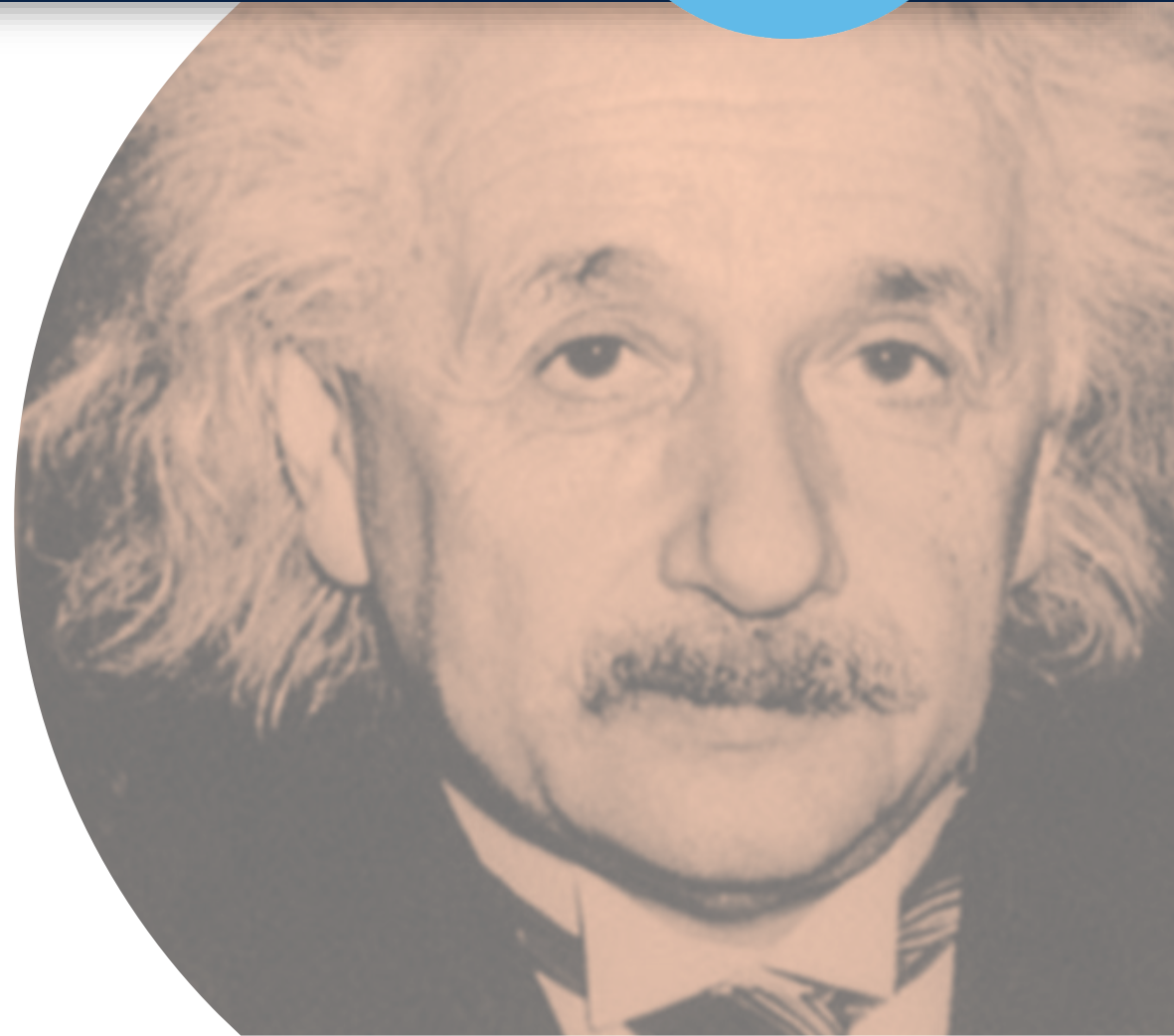

6. I save some but don't think about it much.

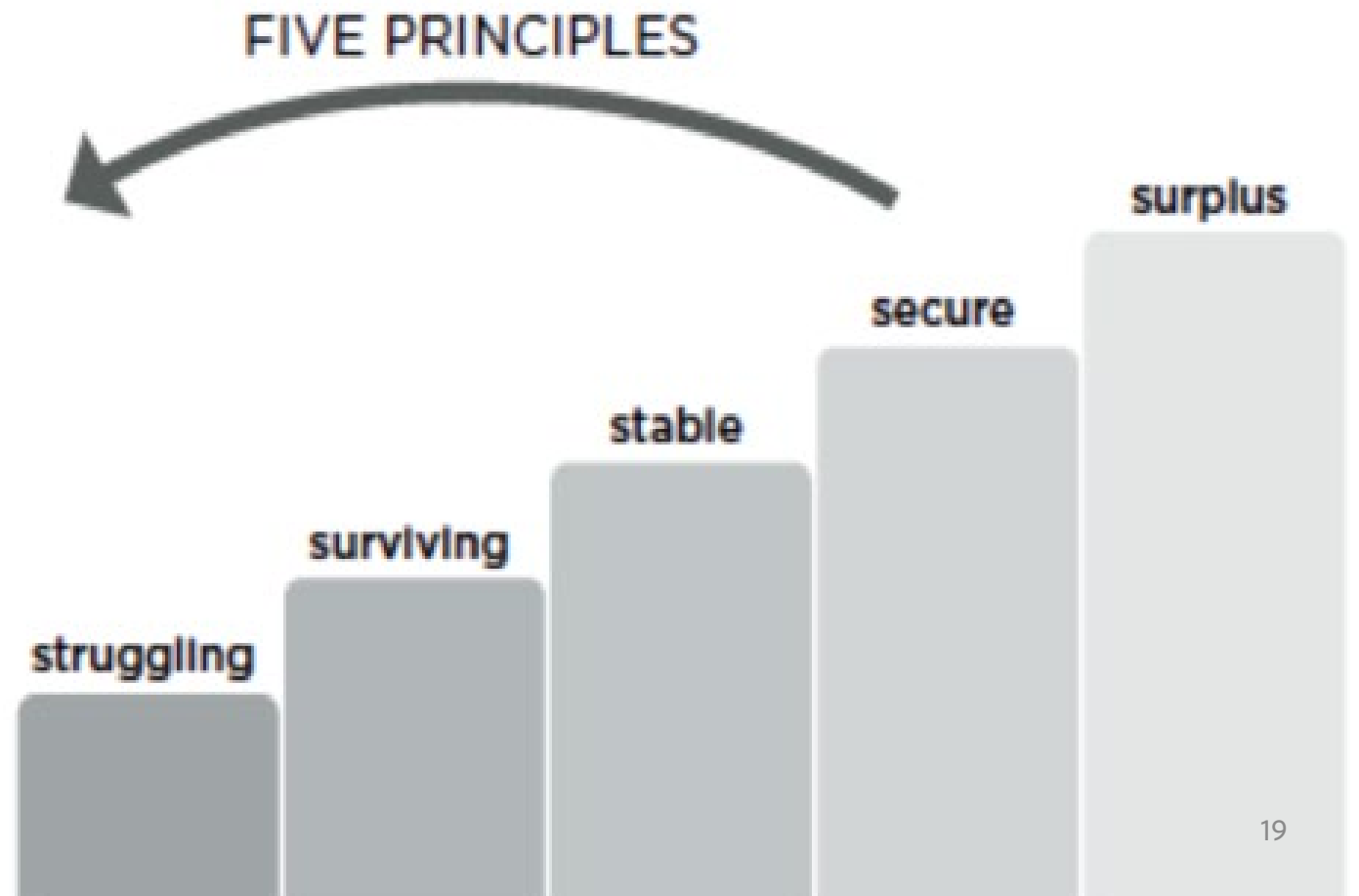
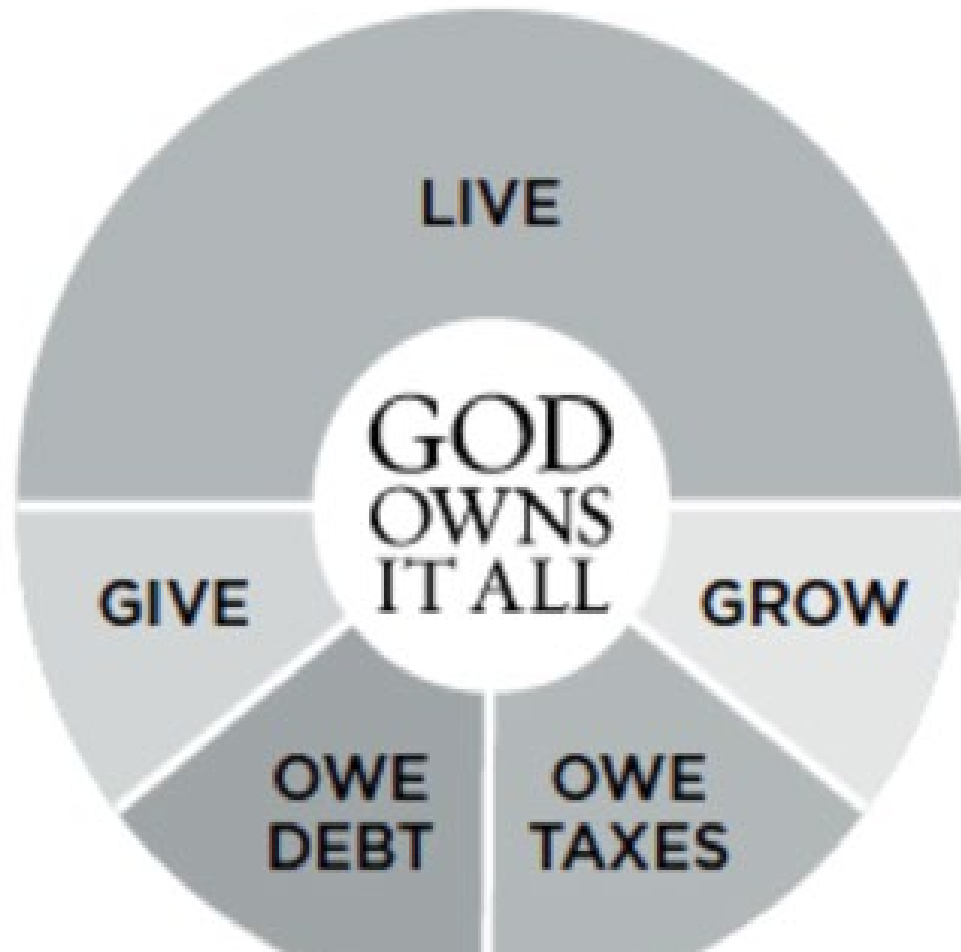
