Jeremiah 29:4-7, 11-13 (ESV)

- <sup>4</sup> Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, to all the exiles whom I have sent into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon:
- <sup>5</sup> Build houses and live in them; plant gardens and eat their produce.
- <sup>6</sup> Take wives and have sons and daughters; take wives for your sons, and give your daughters in marriage, that they may bear sons and daughters; multiply there, and do not decrease.
- <sup>7</sup> But seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the LORD on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare.
- <sup>11</sup> For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.
- <sup>12</sup> Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will hear you.
- 13 You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart.
