## Psalms 115:3-8

## Exodus 20:1-17

- 1 Then God spoke all these words, saying,
- 2" I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.
- 3 " You shall have no other gods before Me.
- 4 "You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth.
- 5 "You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me,
- 6" but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.
- 7" You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain.
- 8 "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
- 9" Six days you shall labor and do all your work,
- 10" but the seventh day is a Sabbath of the Lord your God; in it you shall not do any work, you or your son or your daughter, your male or your female servant or your cattle or your sojourner who stays with you.
- 11 "For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day; therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.
- 12" Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the Lord your God gives you.
- 13 "You shall not murder.
- 14" You shall not commit adultery.
- 15" You shall not steal.
- 16 "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- 17 "You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife or his male servant or his female servant or his ox or his donkey or anything that belongs to your neighbor."
