Genesis 2:22-23, 25

22 And the Lord God fashioned into a woman the rib which He had taken from the man, and brought her to the man.

23 And the man said, "This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man."

25 And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed.

Leviticus 20:10

10 If there is a man who commits adultery with another man's wife, one who commits adultery with his friend's wife, the adulterer and the adulteress shall surely be put to death.

1. Extra-Marital Sex

God forbids extra-marital sex because:

- 1) Sex is designed as a tool for <u>building</u> a marriage while adultery uses sex to destroy a marriage.
- 2) Adultery betrays a <u>covenantal oath</u>.
- 3) Adultery betrays an innocent spouse.
- 4) Adultery destroys a <u>family</u>, often impacting future generations.

To Those Marrieds Who Have Never Committed Adultery:

1) Be aware of the environments which make one susceptible to the temptations of adultery.

Environments:

- 1) Parental Problems
- 2) Low Self-esteem
- 3) Destabilized Life Situations
- 4) Marital Conflict
- 5) Isolation
- 6) Diminished Spiritual Disciplines
- 7) Unusual Spiritual Warfare

- 2) Keep your spiritual pilgrimage progressing.
- 3) Discipline your eye to look straight ahead.
- 4) Distance yourself from relationships which could lead to the temptation of adultery.
- 5) Keep your activities pure.
- 6) Surround yourself with 2 or 3 accountable friends.
- 7) Work at strengthening your relationship with your spouse.

To those involved in adultery:

- 1) Confess it as sin and repent.
- 2) Put an end to it.
- 3) Seek help.
