⁹ *not as a result of works, that no one should boast.*

3 tenses of grace:

Past - Justification - Penalty

Present - Sanctification - Power

Future - Glorification - Presence

Romans 5:1-2

¹ *Therefore having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,*

² *through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.*

Romans 5:20-21

²⁰ *And the Law came in that the transgression might increase; but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more,*

²¹ *that, as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.*

“Introduction” - Denotes the privilege of approaching or being introduced into the presence of someone of high status & especially as of a royal or divine personage
