Matthew 28:18-20

¹⁸ And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

I. What do we do?

We embrace His way. (Jesus is King) (v. 18-20a)

2 ways we embrace His way:

We live under His loving Lordship.

We take up His mission.

II. Will we be alone?

We <u>rest</u> in His <u>presence</u>. (His name is Emmanuel) (v. 20b)

His presence makes us bold as lions.

His presence makes us meek or humble as lambs.

III. Where is our sense of security?

We boldly anticipate His return. (Christ is Victor) (v. 20c)
