### **Speaking Gifts**

1. <u>Prophecy</u> – Two Views

The Static View The God-given ability to proclaim God's truth in a timely and culturally sensitive fashion with a view toward edification, correction, and repentance. The Dynamic View The God-given ability to speak human words to report something God brings to mind.

- 2. <u>Teaching</u> The God-given desire and ability to understand, explain, and apply God's Word to the lives of those listening.
- 3. <u>Exhortation</u> The God-given ability to arouse others to action, causing them to follow a specific course of action.
- 4. <u>Evangelism</u> The God-given desire and ability to effectively communicate the message of the gospel of Christ to unbelievers.
- 5. <u>Pastor/Teacher</u> The God-given desire and ability to pastor God's people primarily through the proclaiming and teaching of God's Word.

### Serving Gifts

- 1. <u>Shepherding (pastor)</u> The God-given desire and ability to provide leadership, care and nurture for individuals or groups of people in the church over an extended period of time.
- 2. <u>Service</u> The God-given ability to detect and meet needs through various expressions of love and labor. Some examples are these: Hospitality – The God-given desire and ability to provide an environment of inclusion for new and needy people. Craftsmanship – The God-given desire and ability to facilitate the ministry by constructing the necessary tools for ministry. Musical & Creative Communication – The God-given ability to communicate God's truth through a variety of art forms.
- 3. <u>Mercy</u> The God-given ability to hurt for those who hurt and to do what is necessary to help relieve them from their distress.
- 4. <u>Leadership</u> The God-given ability to attract, lead, and motivate people to accomplish their work of ministry.
- 5. <u>Administration</u> The God-given ability to give guidance and direction to the people and affairs of the church.
- 6. <u>Giving</u> The God-given desire and ability to contribute money and material resources to the work of the Lord, with cheerfulness and liberality.
- 7. <u>Faith</u> The God-given ability to believe God for the unlikely.

## Sign Gifts

- 1. <u>Word Of Wisdom</u> The God-given insight and ability which would only be given by divine intervention enabling one to apply information effectively.
- 2. <u>Word Of Knowledge</u> The God-given ability to know something that could only be known by God's intervention.
- 3. <u>Miracles</u> The God-given ability to discern and pray effectively for the supernatural.
- 4. <u>Healing</u> The ability to discern and pray effectively for healing.
- 5. <u>Distinguishing Of Spirits</u> The unnatural ability to distinguish between truth and error.
- 6. <u>Tongues</u> The God-given ability to speak a language not learned humanly.
- 7. Interpretation Of Tongues The God-given ability to interpret languages not previously learned.
