Table Discussion #1:

1. After reading through chapter 1, what observations can you make about Paul and his message to Timothy? Were there any repetitions, names, contrasts, indicatives/imperatives?
2. In verses 9 and 10, Paul lays out the Gospel. Paul has already pointed out Timothy's sincere faith. Why do you think he expresses it here? What part of the Gospel might get misunderstood or forgotten over time?
3. What do you think Paul meant by "guard the good deposit entrusted to you" in verse 14? Why might this be important for Timothy? Why is this important for us now?
4. Did you gain anything new in your reading this week: a new insight, word...? Something new about God/Jesus/Holy Spirit?
