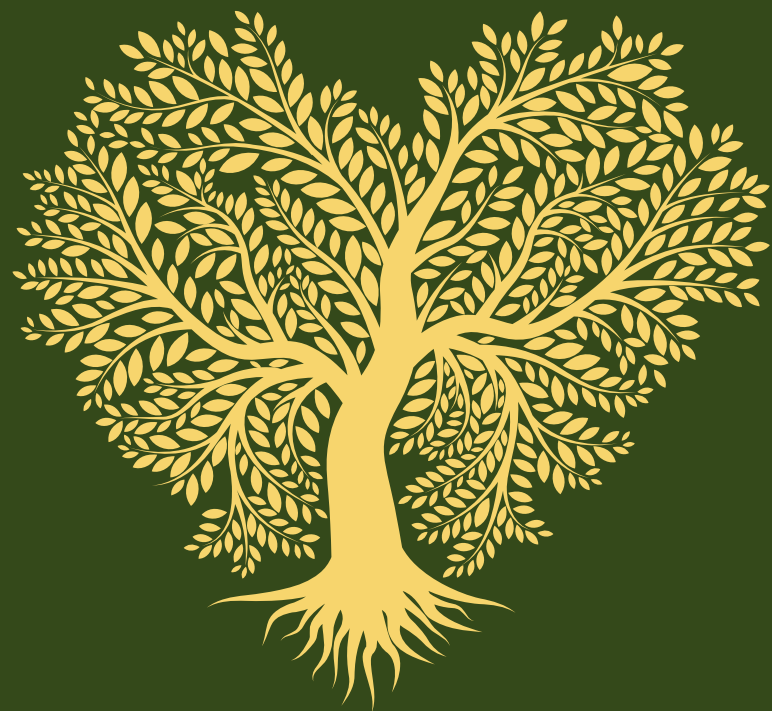


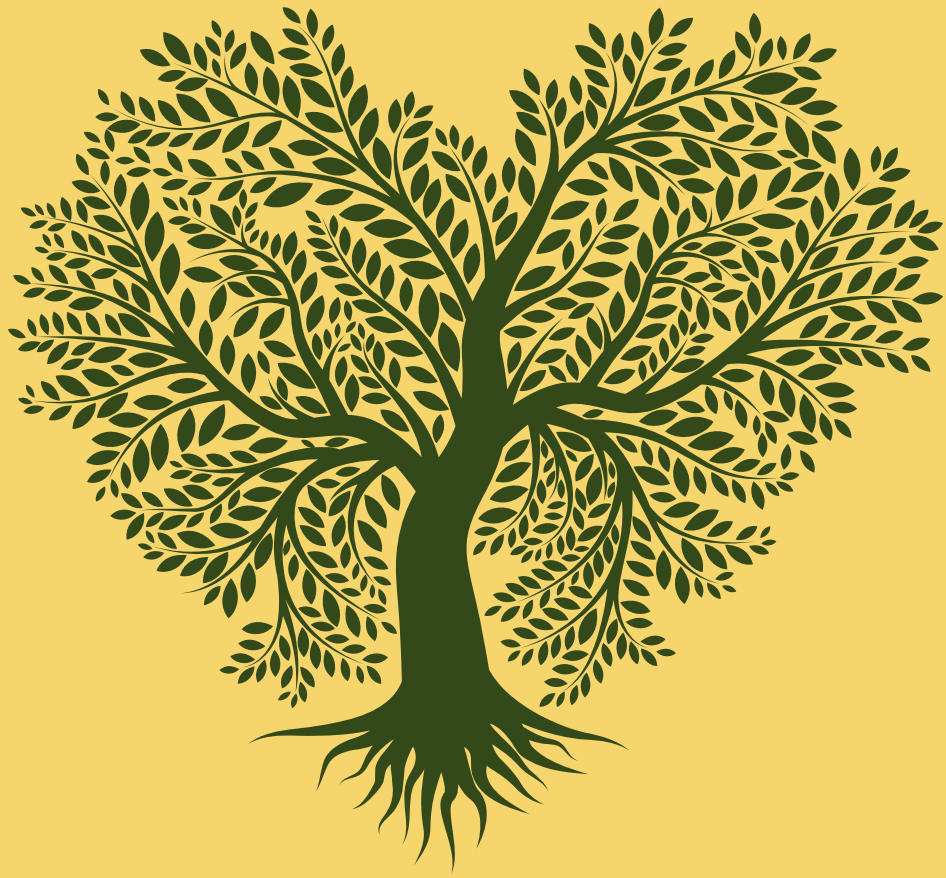

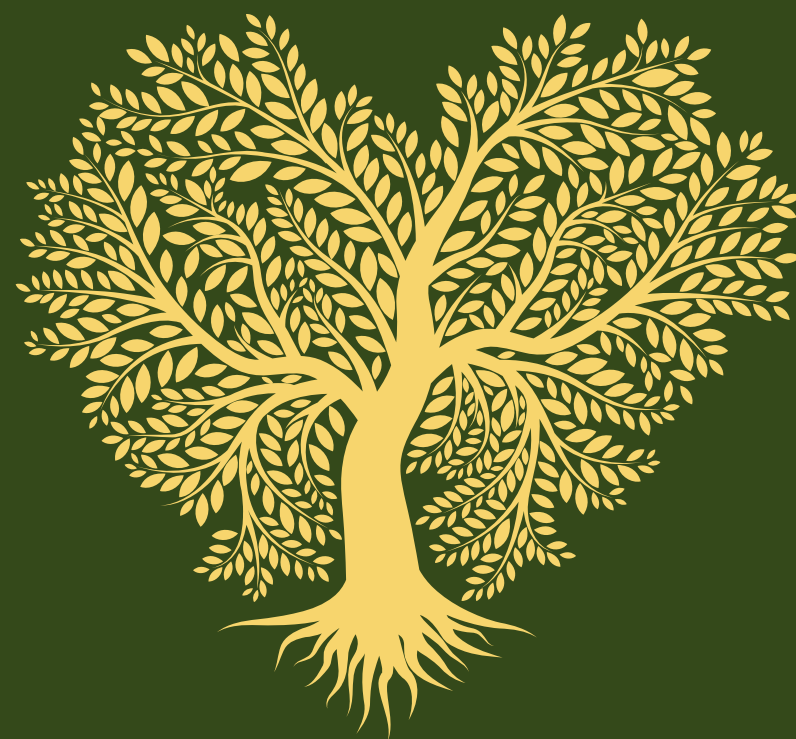

Do not be ashamed

difference between shame & embarrassment

Embarrassment:

- a response to a social situation where others might think you are strange*
- a reaction to an inconsistency between your behavior and your idea of yourself*
- can be intense, but is usually fleeting and can be brushed off*

Shame

- a feeling of humiliation or embarrassment
caused by doing something immoral, improper,
or dishonorable.*
- a more substantial feeling than embarrassment
because it pertains to your moral character
(which can feel like your identity)*
- can leave you feeling worthless, lonely, and
disconnected*

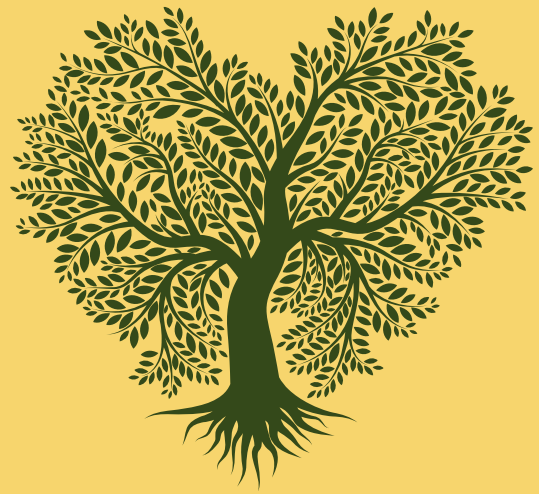

Lectio Divina

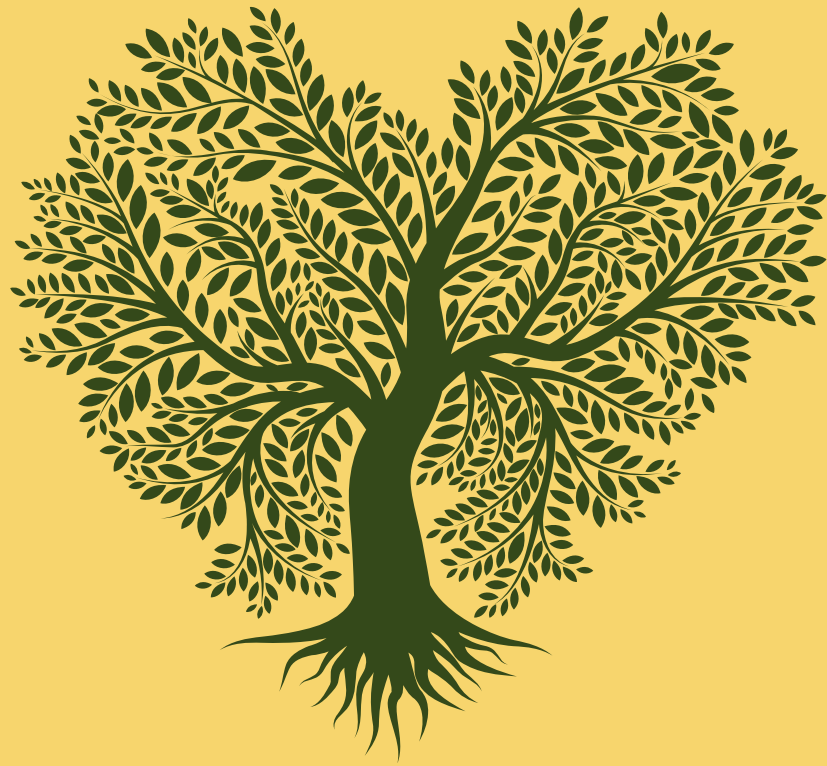


1st: Listen for a word or phrase
