



# Do not be ashamed

difference between shame & embarassment

**Embarrassment:** -a response to a social situation where others might think you are strange -a reaction to an inconsistency between your behavior and your idea of yourself -can be intense, but is usually fleeting and can be brushed off

### Shame

- -a feeling of humiliation or embarrassment
- cuased by doing something immoral, improper, or dishonorable.
- -a more substantial feeling than embarrassment
  - because it pertains to your moral character
    - (which can feel like your identity)
  - -can leave you feeling worthless, lonely, and
    - disconnected




