
2. A CULTURALLY RELEVANT TOOLSET

- 1) Four Types Of Tools
 - (1) Introductory Tools
 - (2) Primary Tools
 - (3) Support Tools
 - (4) Follow Up Tools
- 2) Characteristics Of Effective Tools
 - (1) Tools designed with the belief that God does the converting, using His most powerful tool, the Bible
 - (2) Tools which are relevant to the culture in which they are used
 - tract evangelism (1-D)
 - monologue evangelism (2-D)
 - a <u>single</u> appointment <u>presentation</u> designed for <u>prepared</u> people
 - dialogue evangelism (3-D)
 - a <u>multiple</u> appointment <u>conversation</u> designed for unprepared people





