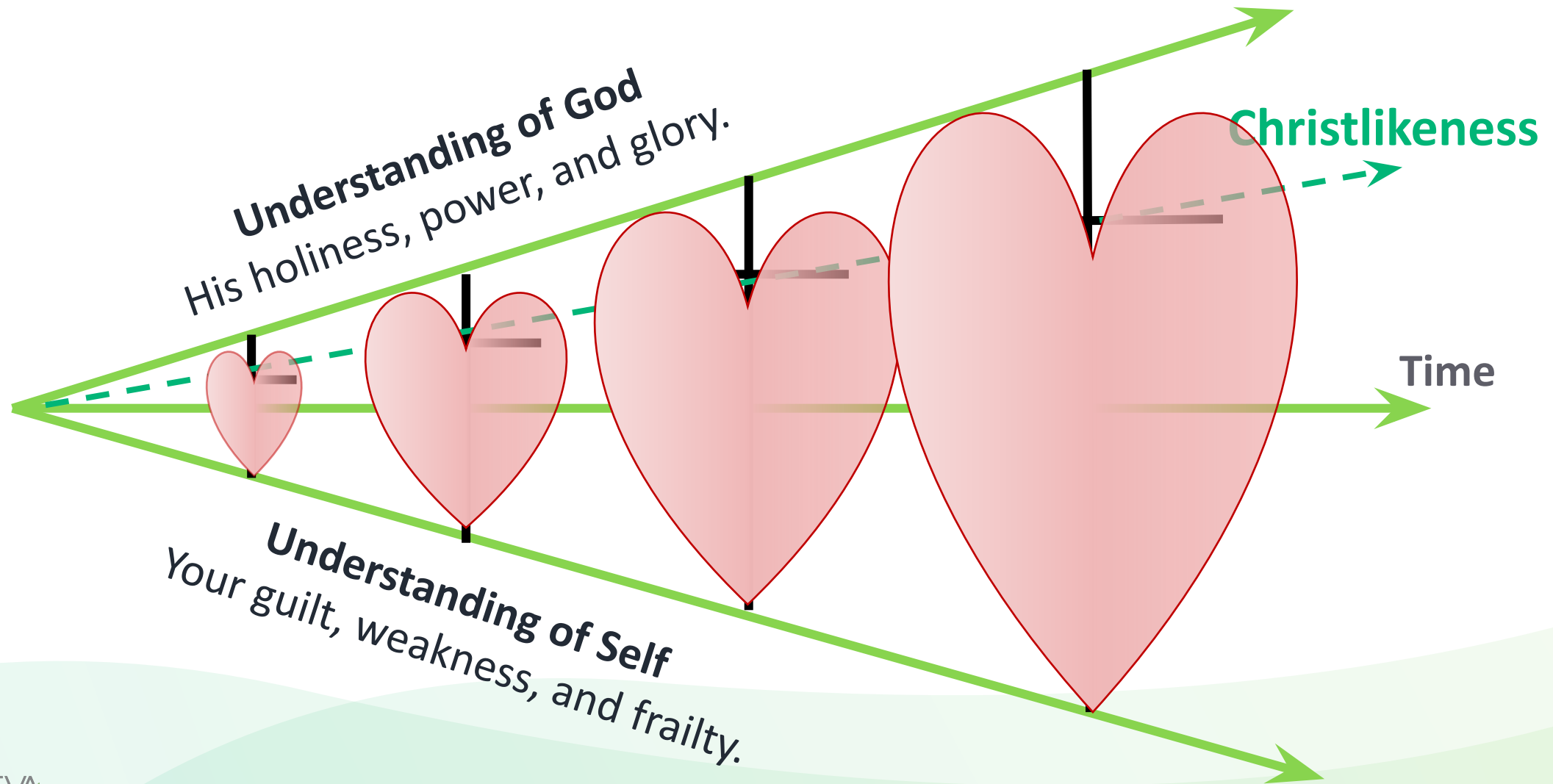
Many Callings

Life of Faith

1. Abram/Abraham – 2000-1825 BC

- Leaves Ur at 70 (Genesis 11:26)
- God calls him to go at 75 (Genesis 12:1-7)
- Promise of a son at 85 (Genesis 14)
- Isaac born at 100 (Genesis 21)
- Faith tested at 115 (Genesis 22)
- Called home at 175 (Genesis 25)

Life of Faith

1. Joseph – 1700-1650 BC

- Born in Haran (Genesis 30:25-26)
- Leaves for Canaan with family from age 6-17 (Genesis 31)
- Gets coat and sold into slavery at 17 (Genesis 37)
- Serves Potiphar, imprisoned from 17-29 (Genesis 39-41)
- Serves Pharaoh from 30-110 (Genesis 41-47)
- Called home at 110 (Genesis 50)

Life of Faith

1. Moses – 1520-1400 BC

- Born in Egypt and lives as a prince until 40 (Exodus 2)
- Flees to Midian at 40 (Exodus 2)
- Works as shepherd from age 40-80 (Exodus 2-3)
- God calls him to lead Israel out of Egypt at 80 (Exodus 3)
- Leads Israel in the wilderness from 80 to 120 (Exodus 4-40)
- Called home at 120 (Deuteronomy 34)

Life of Faith

1. Peter 1 BC – 68 AD

- Born in Bethsaida
- Works as fisherman from age 14 to 30
- Participates in Jesus earthly ministry from age 31 to 34
- Leads the early Christian Church from age 34 to 49 (Acts)
- Rebuked by Paul around age 49 to 56 (Galatians)
- Writes 1 & 2 Peter from age 63-69

Fruitfulness and faithfulness in Different Seasons

Theology of Sanctification means...

- Galatians 5:22 – fruit of the spirit
- Romans 12:13; Hebrews 13:2; 1 Peter 4:9 - hospitality
- Titus 2:1-10
- 2 Corinthians 9:6-15 - generous
- Colossians 1:21-23 - steadfast
