



- Visited in 2002
- Approximately 3300 people: HIV impacted
- Many widows with no means of support
- Many orphaned children; no education
- Drought








"Many widows, HIV impacted"

- Expand Siha School Capacity





This is What Success Looks Like! "An Education and Access"



- A church involved through Going and Sharing Four Full Time and Two Part Time Missionaries
- Over 450 people went on Journeys to Tanzania
- Over 50 people have gone multiple trips
- 538 Children have been sponsored (725 Inc Compassion)
- Over a 100 Facetime Calls with individual Children
- Continued Prayer by the Church for Tanzania and vice versa
