A simplified kind of sentence diagram is a mechanical layout of the text. This one keeps the words in the order of the text, but emphasizes relationships between clauses and phrases more than the grammatical function of individual words.

This helps the student to see at a glance the primary elements of a passage and their relationship to each other. The process of developing the layout forces the interpreter to ask questions and make observations about the structure of the passage."
